

**The Notification of National Science and Technology Development Agency  
Regarding Prohibitions on the Use of International Online Databases Subscribed by  
National Science and Technology Development Agency in 2025**

---

National Science and Technology Development Agency (NSTDA) has subscribed to international online databases for the year 2025 to support research and development activities and to enhance the knowledge of NSTDA personnel. In order to ensure responsible use of the databases in accordance with terms of use agreed to between NSTDA and the database service providers and to prevent unauthorized or inappropriate use that could violate the prohibitions of the use of databases, which would impact NSTDA personnel and NSTDA as a whole, therefore, this notification regarding prohibitions on the use of international online databases subscribed by NSTDA in 2025 must be established.

By virtue of Section 15 of the Science and Technology Development Act B.E. 2534 (1991), the prohibitions on the use of international online databases subscribed by NSTDA in 2025 are hereby established as follows:

1. Do not use the databases for any purpose other than for academic research or educational purposes.
2. Do not distribute, reproduce, or transmit the content from the databases by any means and must not publish the content on private, or public websites, or on any public networks.
3. Do not post abstracts from the databases on websites or social media in any form.
4. Do not use automated tools or software such as robot, spider, crawler, or any automated downloading devices to search, scrape, extract, deep link, index and/or disrupt the operation of the databases.
5. Do not download data from the databases to the server of NSTDA or any third party systemically.
6. Do not substantially or systematically reproduce, retain, store locally, redistribute or disseminate the content from the databases on personal devices or other storage devices.
7. Do not use or assist third parties in using the databases for commercial purposes including but not limited to selling, reselling, lending, transferring, uploading to commercial websites, or charging fees for access.

8. Do not remove, obscure, or modify in any way any copyright notices, other proprietary notices, trademarks, logos, service marks, any other rights indications, or disclaimers as they appear in or on the databases.

9. Do not shorten, modify, translate, create derivative works, or adapt the databases into any other service, or conduct the above activities by based on the databases, including do not do the abovementioned actions using artificial intelligence (AI) in any way.

10. Do not use the databases in combination with artificial intelligence (AI), including tasks such as training algorithms, testing, processing, analysis, generating results, or developing artificial intelligence (AI) in any form.

11. Do not use any content or any part of the content from the databases in combination with generative AI system for purposes such as developing, training, modifying or enhancing such system, or authorize or grant any rights to any third party to do the abovementioned activities in any way.

Any activity that violates or infringes the above prohibitions may result in the suspension of access to databases for NSTDA and NSTDA personnel, therefore, any individual found in breach shall be personally liable for the legal consequences of such violation or infringement.

Please be advised and be adhered to as a guideline for future practice.
