Criteria for the proposal selection

Criteria	Explanations	Importance
1. A topic of the research proposal corresponding with the nation's demand and matching the specialties of the researcher/ the advisor with the available research funds.	The research matches the national development goals.	Extremely Important
2. Cooperation between the advisor and the researcher	The researcher and the advisor sincerely share the same interests and cooperate to develop the graduate and produce the research work.	Extremely Important
3. The advisor potentials	Carry out the research and previously work with the NSTDA researcher; the advisor track records would be checked.	Extremely Important
4. The number of TGIST students who are under the supervision of the advisor	Too many students could result in potential declines under the supervision; the ideal number is no more than 3.	Fairly Important
5. The student's potentials	The student has exceptional research skills and has the GPA or the academic work as specified.	Important
